

- ❖ Strong's Dictionary (from Greek, first Century)
 - ❖ A learner, pupil
 - ❖ Indicating thought accompanied by endeavor (Romans 12:2)
 - ❖ Denotes one who follows one's teachings
 - ❖ Defined by Jesus in John 8:31
 - ❖ Of all who manifest that they are His disciples by abiding in His Word
 - ❖ A disciple was not only a pupil, but an adherent; hence they are spoken of as imitators of their teacher.
 - ❖ Acts 4:13 – they understood that Peter and John were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and began to recognize them as having been with Jesus.
