

# Covenant

An oath-bound promise whereby one party solemnly pledges to bless or serve another party in some specific way.

Depends on the meeting of certain conditions by the party to whom the promise was made.

“Berit” – Old Testament, For a binding relationship between two parties

“Karat Berit” – to cut a covenant
